Role 1: Social Media Co-ordinator

Position overview: WiSEAN is seeking a passionate and skilled Social Media Coordinator to join our team of volunteers. As the Social Media Co-ordinator, you will play a crucial role in amplifying our mission and objectives through strategic social media management and engagement. You will have the opportunity to shape our online presence, foster meaningful connections and contribute to the advancement of research on women in sport and exercise.

Roles and responsibilities:

- Assist in (in collaboration with WiSEAN directors) developing and executing a social-media strategy to promote WISEAN's mission, events, mentoring scheme, podcasts and other WiSEAN activities across social-media platforms, namely X and Instagram.
- 2. Create and post engaging and relevant content tailored to our target audience, including, but not limited to, pictures, graphics, videos and infographics.
- 3. Monitor social media performance metrics on a quarterly basis, analyse data, evaluate effectiveness and identify opportunities for improvement.
- 4. Engage with followers, divert enquiries to relevant individuals/experts and foster meaningful interactions to cultivate a vibrant and supportive online community.
- 5. Stay up to date with the latest social media trends, tools and best practices, and provide recommendations to WiSEAN directors for optimisation and innovation.

- 1. Good understanding of social-media platforms, algorithms, trends and best practices.
- 2. Excellent communication skills, with the ability to craft compelling and research-informed content tailored to diverse audiences.
- 3. Creative thinker with a keen eye for design to develop engaging multimedia content.
- 4. Proficiency in basic graphic design software (i.e., software that is freely available).
- 5. Ability to work independently and work flexibly (to respond to new trends in research on women's sport and exercise).

Role 2: Host for WiSEAN Webinars

Position overview: We are seeking a dynamic and passionate individual to serve as the host for the Women in Sport and Exercise Academic Network's webinars, to take place at least once per quarter. As the host, you will play a pivotal role in finding suitable guest speakers, facilitating engaging and productive discussions, fostering a supportive environment and ensuring the smooth execution of the webinars.

Roles and responsibilities:

- 1. Identify and liaise with speakers to develop relevant and compelling content for each webinar, aligning with the network's mission and objectives.
- 2. Organise the logistical aspects of each webinar, including scheduling, technology setup and any other necessary arrangements.
- Serve as the primary point of contact for all communication related to the webinars, including sending out invitations to speakers and promoting to attendees (mainly WiSEAN members), sending reminders and providing content for posting on WiSEAN social media accounts.
- 4. Lead the webinars with professionalism and enthusiasm, guiding discussions and ensuring all attendees can contribute.
- 5. Record, edit (where necessary) and prepare webinars for posting on the WiSEAN website.

- 1. A background in sport and exercise, with a good understanding of the issues facing research and researchers in women's sport and exercise.
- 2. Excellent verbal and written communication skills, with the ability to facilitate discussions effectively.
- 3. Exceptional interpersonal skills and the ability to build rapport with diverse groups of individuals, fostering a welcoming, supportive and inclusive environment.
- Comfortable using technology platforms for webinars, such as Zoom or Teams, and familiar with digital tools for communication and editing that you have at your disposal.

Role 3: Blog Editor

Position overview: WiSEAN is seeking a passionate and skilled Blog Editor to join our team of volunteers. This role is ideal for someone who is enthusiastic about promoting women's research in sport and exercise, has a keen eye for quality content and is skilled in curating and editing blog posts. The Blog Editor will be responsible for requesting, compiling and editing blogs for the WiSEAN website.

Roles and responsibilities:

- Request high-quality blogs from WiSEAN members, ensuring that a diverse range of topics and perspectives are represented. Stay updated with the latest trends in the research to ensure content relevancy.
- 2. Compile and organise blog posts for easy access and navigation on the WiSEAN website.
- Work closely with the WiSEAN team to align blog content with the organisation's
 mission and objectives, and to ensure blog authors follow the guidelines regarding
 style and format. Communicate guidelines to blog authors and request permission to
 feature their content on the WiSEAN website.
- 4. Review and edit blog posts for accuracy, editorial consistency and relevancy. Ensure all content is properly credited and sources are accurately cited.
- 5. Collaborate with the WiSEAN directors and social media volunteer to promote blogs across WiSEAN's social media platforms.

- 1. Strong research skills and the ability to identify high-quality blog content.
- 2. Excellent written and verbal communication skills.
- 3. Attention to detail and experience in editing written work.
- 4. A genuine passion for growing, promoting and strengthening research on women in sport and exercise, with a commitment to advancing WiSEAN's mission and objectives.

Role 4: Sponsorship Co-ordinator

Position overview: We are seeking a proactive individual to serve as a Sponsorship Coordinator for WiSEAN. The primary responsibility of this role is to identify, engage and secure sponsors for our podcasts, events and various activities.

Roles and responsibilities:

- 1. Work with WiSEAN directors to identify further potential sponsors that align with WiSEAN's mission and objectives.
- 2. Cultivate relationships with potential (and current) sponsors and ensure regular communication and updates on the impact of their sponsorship.
- 3. Oversee the sponsorship process, including sponsor expectations.
- 4. Work closely with the WISEAN team to understand our activities, ensuring alignment in sponsorship messaging and goals.
- 5. Track and report on sponsorship activities, including the impact of sponsorship contributions.

- 1. Experience in identifying sponsors, preferably in the fields of academia, gender or sports-related initiatives.
- 2. Good written and verbal communication skills, with the ability to create proposals for sponsors that effectively communicate WiSEAN's mission and objectives.
